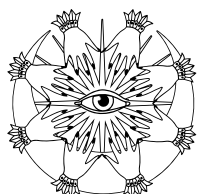

## GANG OF WITCHES, IBIZA PODCAST

### Tanit\* is back

Until the crisis of Covid, Ibiza was subject to summer tourist pressure\*\* which was certainly its source of income, but it resulted as well in gentrification, and had disastrous ecological consequences. Today, the island is experiencing an unprecedented global crisis that calls for major structural changes.

It is in this context that every new moon, Jo Youle receives witches who change the world in general, and Ibiza in particular. Together, they explore how ecofeminism can be applied locally for more social and ecological justice on the island.

*\* Tanit is the tutelary goddess of Ibiza. She is a Punic goddess who arrived with the Phoenicians in the 7th century BC. Her cult can be compared to the other Goddess cults practiced until 3000 BC (appearance of the patriarchy). Even today she still occupies a central place in the island's folklore.*

*\*\* The island of barely 572 square kilometres and 142,000 inhabitants welcomed nearly 3 million tourists in 2019.*



## GANG OF WITCHES, MANIFESTO

Our artistic community, GANG OF WITCHES, was born in 2016. This multifaceted project is meant to grow during 9 consecutive years, each one being dedicated to a celestial body, cosmic and archetypal silver lining of this artistic adventure. Our major objective is to establish a protected space for reflection, exchange and creation, a bubble undisturbed by any productive constraints, rich in singular propositions, fertile, powerful, committed.

The witch, knowledgeable, independent and powerful, often feared, sometimes mocked, always with a halo of mystery, the witch is the master of her identity. Her image marks the place of women in society and the combats of each era. Since the 1960's she is a feminist, ecologist, anti-capitalist icon, and the perfect symbol for our gang.

Gang Of Witches deploys autonomous and alternative means of diffusion, through the publication of books, the organization of events, the production of podcasts, a documentary series, and an eponymous music project. Their mission is to present our latest creations and other artists', to share our battles, as well as thinkers' and activists' that are resonating with our philosophy, widening our circle every day.
